### ADVANCED MEDICAL EQUIPMENT FOR BETTER TREATMENT FOR THE NEONATES

United Way of Baroda established a Neonatal Intensive Care unit/Paediatric Care Unit at Medical Care Centre Trust, Kashiben Gordhandas Patel Children Hospital, Vadodara in the year 1986. **Till date, more than 30000+ Neonates** have received progressive treatment. In order to provide better and advanced treatment purpose of the New-borns, **26 Advanced Medical equipment** along with accessories to upgrade the entire NICU/PICU Unit costing to INR 13 Lakhs which included: Semi Fowler Bed with Locker and IV Stand, Multipara Monitor, Fogger Machine, Philips ETCO2 Monitor, Volumetric Pump and Syringe Infusion Pump.



### DIGITAL SUPPORT FOR THE UNDERPRIVILEGED STUDENTS

Under United-Fusion Study Foundation Program, **40 needy students** were provided with Advanced Dell Laptop to ease their studies. This flagship program has been successfully implementing **since last 17 years** in which **more than 1000 students** have been supported for their complete graduation/post-graduation. **591 students** have graduated and **457** have been employed in National or Multinational companies, are well settled and supporting their families. **For the year 2022-23 batch, 500+ new applications received to select indigent bright students.**





### EFFORTS TOWARDS SCHOOL ENHANCEMENT

As a part of strengthening the access to quality education along with maintaining sustainable environment, United Way of Baroda provided **2 Smart Panels, 30 School Benches, 1 Smart TV, 1 Epson projector along with educational software with 3 year subscription, 1 Water Cooler and 1 Solar Roof Top System (6 KV)** to the MES School, Vadodara. This support will cater to **more than 900+ students** for their holistic development.

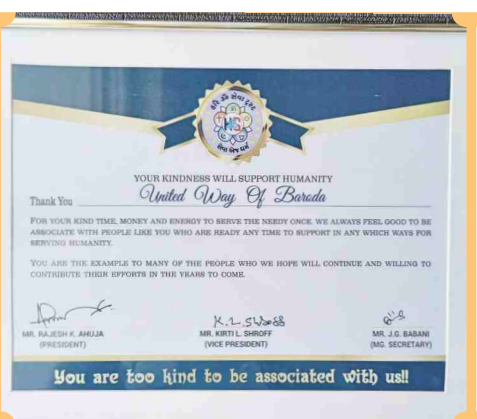
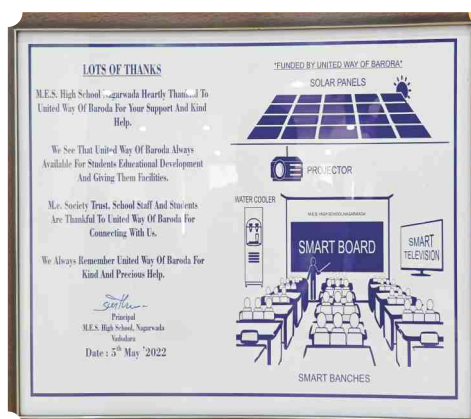


### SUPPORT FOR THE DIFFERENTLY ABLED INDIVIDUAL

## DIGITAL EDUCATION SUPPORT FOR GOVERNMENT SCHOOL



United Way of Baroda joined hands with Palvi Industries established and inaugurated an Advanced Computer Laboratory for NPSS School, Vadodara where **more than 960 students** will have access to computer technology.

This Computer Laboratory has advanced 10 HP Computers with latest processor, Windows 10, MS Office, and other computer peripherals were installed in the school. Complete furniture with platforms, 15 chairs, Air Conditioning system, and electrical work taking into consideration of safety of the students. In addition, Customised mouse pads, educational mural painting along with a green board and computer covers, were also provided.

The Advanced Computer Laboratory was inaugurated by Chairman (NPSS)- Mr. Hitesh Patni, Managing Director (Palvi Industries)- Mr. Himanshu Mehta, Director (Palvi Industries)- Mrs. Vibha Mehta, and Chief Executive Officer (United Way of Baroda)- Dr. Binita Verdia. ## RURAL RISING PROJECT : INAUGURATION OF THREE MAJOR COMPONENTS



Under Rural Rising Project, focussing on three major components including Education, Health and Environment: Advanced Smart Classrooms were established to create access to quality education, 150 LPH Water RO Cooler Systemr was installed to provide access to purified drinking water, and Solar Roof Top Systems were placed to reduce the burden of expenses in terms of electricity and also to protect the environment. **More than 257 students** are provided with better environment for their holistic development.



## TRANSPORTATION SUPPORT FOR THE DILIGENTS



As a part of an extended support, United Way of Baroda in association with Ami Life Sciences Pvt Ltd donated **32-Seater School Bus** for the rural students of Shri Janta Vidhyalay, Thorkhan village of Amreli District, Gujarat to ease for the students to reach the school on time. In addition, to support the administration function of Government Primary School of Amreli District, the school has been provided with 1 Advanced HP Desktop Computer along with peripherals and all-in-one printer.

## AMPHITHEATRE ESTABLISHMENT AND SOLAR ROOF TOP INSTALLATION



United Way of Baroda in collaboration with Lanoz Real Estate-Infrastructure Pvt Ltd. and Jan Priya Trust established an Amphitheatre for creating a platform for the students of practicing school culture, social competitions and activity base learning. In addition, a Solar Roof Top System has been installed in the school for reducing the expenses cost in terms of electricity and also to maintain environment sustainability.

## URBAN PRIMARY HEALTH CENTRES UPGRADATION



**7 Urban Primary Health Centres** were in dire need to upgrade their laboratory for better treatment purpose of the patients. United Way of Baroda and CSR Partner SABIC Innovative Plastics Pvt Ltd extended its support and upgraded the laboratory of all 7 Urban Primary Health Centre which is individually serving population of about 50000 people and an OPD of 100-120 patients of daily basis.

Upgradation of Laboratory included renovating the platform inside the laboratory, creating storage cabinets, equipment- Haematology Counter with support for 2 years of laboratory reagents, a refrigerator to store the samples, an air conditioner inside the laboratory along with electrification facilities consisting of Uninterruptible Power Supply (UPS) Unit and Residual Current Circuit Breaker (RCCB) Unit to ensure the safety of the machinery as well as the tests being conducted in the laboratory.
